We are currently looking for a laboratory-based scientist to fill a 'Team Leader: Drug Discovery' post to drive our in-house small molecule drug discovery programs.

**Who we are:**

We are a Biotech Start-up located in Cambridge, UK that seeks to open up new 'druggable' target space using a cutting-edge approach called *Protein Interference® (Protein-i)*, which has the ability to identify hidden, or cryptic, drug sites in disease-relevant proteins, and then target those sites with first-in-class small molecule therapeutics.

**Roles and responsibilities:**

- Advise senior and executive management and contribute to strategic planning
- Drive the development and prosecution of assay cascades in a timely manner to progress programs
- Liaise with external chemistry providers to coordinate synthetic chemistry and compound profiling
- Integrate with other providers including crystallography CROs to provide structural biology guidance, and *in vivo* CRO to deliver efficacy studies
- Assist in the management of external drug discovery focused collaborations to ensure that technical and reporting milestones are met
- Manage in-house resource to achieve these goals
